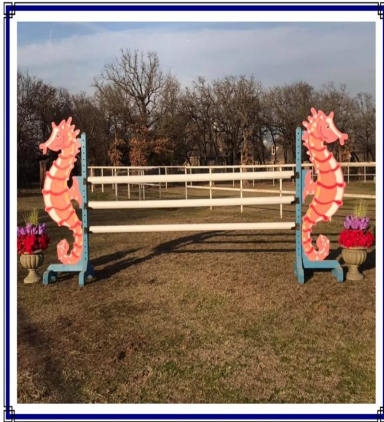

# Rules and Guidelines

- **Entries:** Please submit entries via the link on the previous page. Entries are due by **Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>**, A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received later than Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM. Stall requests received after 7:00 PM on Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup> will increase \$25 per stall.
- **Class Fees:** \$20 per class. All Hunter Derby Fees: \$55. Jumper and Hunter Classics: \$40. Stalls: \$100. Shavings: \$10/Bag (3 Minimum) No outside shavings allowed
- **Fees:** Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$5 per day. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$10 office/\$5 scholarship fee/\$5 Benefit fee will be charged at \$20 per entry. A \$35 grounds fee will be charge per horse per day that do NOT rent a stall. An early move in fee of \$50 per stall for any horses that move in before 8:00am Friday morning. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-members of NTHJC will be charged a \$20 fee. NTHJC memberships can be paid at the show or online at [NTHJC.com](http://NTHJC.com).
- **NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper Awards:** Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. Year end points will be accrued and awarded at NTHJC Year End banquet.
- **Coggins:** Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Stalls: Stalls are 12'x12' permanent box stalls and will be available 8:00am Friday through Sunday. A \$35 grounds fee will be charged for any horse without a stall. No outside shavings are allowed. A 3 bag minimum is required.
- **RV Space, golf cart rental, and feed orders:** Forms are on website - [www.texasrosehorsepark.com](http://www.texasrosehorsepark.com) and must be completed and mailed in with payment.
- **Arenas:** 2 Arenas are 160'x280' and the third arena is 160'x300', all weather sand footing.
- **Schooling:** There will be open schooling Friday from 8:00 am until 5:30 pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from 6:30am until times stated on schedule. No jumper or Derby schooling.
- **Medal Finals:** Must follow the 6" cross entry rule when entering the Medal Finals, only members will be eligible to compete in the Year End Medal Finals. The Top 8 point earners for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the Year End Show.
- **Limit Divisions:** Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'o at this show.
- **Cross Entries:** A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18".
- **Awards:** All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.
- **Attire:** Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts with collars are allowed at shows June-August. No chaps allowed. Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
- **Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.
- **Concessions:** Available during show hours Saturday & Sunday.
- **Split Classes:** All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split.
