Rules & Regulations

Entries: Please submit entries via the online entry form. Entries may be submitted via the link on the previous page. Release forms can be emailed to amy@equine-events.net. Entries are due by Monday July 19th, A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received after July 21st. Please note: there are two separate shows – one complete show on July 24th and one complete show on July 25th – shows need to be entered individually via the entry form.

Class Fees: \$20 per class. Classics: \$35. Hunter Derby: \$50.

Stalls: \$50 per show (\$100 for both days). Shavings: \$9/Bag (3 Minimum) No outside shavings allowed.

Fees: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$5 per show. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$10 office/\$10 NTHJC scholarship/benefit fee will be charged at \$20 per entry/per show. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-members of NTHJC will be charged a \$20 fee (per show). NTHJC memberships can be paid online at NTHJC.com.

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper Awards: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. Year end points will be accrued and awarded at NTHJC Year End banquet.

Coggins: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to amy@equine-events.net with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival.

Stalls: Stalls will be available noon the day prior through the last day of showing. (ie. Horses showing Saturday only may move in Friday at noon, horses showing Sunday only may move in Saturday at noon. Horses showing both days may move in Friday at noon and stay through end of the day Sunday.) No outside shavings are allowed. A 3 bag minimum is required. Horses not renting a stall will be charged a \$35 grounds fee per show.

Arenas: Both arenas are 150' x 250' with sand footing.

Schooling: There will be open schooling Friday from 1:00pm until 7:00 pm. Schooling available Saturday afternoon as daylight allows until 7:00 PM, and Sunday from 6:30 in all rings except Derby ring. There will be a short schooling break between the Derby and the regular Hunter divisions on Sunday.

Medal Classes: Must follow the 6" cross entry rule when entering the Medal Classes. Open to all riders but only the top 8 point-earning members for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the Year End Show.

Limit Divisions: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

Cross Entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.

Awards: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

Attire: Polo shirts with collars are allowed all classes. No chaps allowed.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

Concessions: Concessions will be available during show hours.

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split.

\$250 Future Jumper Classic

Class 75, entry fee \$35. Fences 2'3. Open to horses competing in the Future Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place. 8 riders minimum to award prize money.

\$250 Puddle Jumper Classic

Class 76, entry fee \$35. Fences 2'6-2'9. Open to horses competing in the Puddle Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place. 8 riders minimum to award prize money.

\$250 Schooling Jumper Classic

Class 77, entry fee \$35. Fences 3'0-3'3. Open to horses competing in the Puddle Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place. 8 riders minimum to award prize money.

\$250 2' Hunter Classic

Class 72, entry fee- \$35. Open to all Jr/ Am riders competing in the 2'0 Jr/Am Hunter Division at this show. The first 2' Jr/Am Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round will be a will be the second 2' Jr/Am Hunter O/F round and will be a handier course with tests such as a trot fence, rollback or halt. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place. Riders must be confirmed entered with the in-gate prior to riding their 1st Hunter O/F round for scores to count.

\$250 2'3 Hunter Classic

Class 73, entry fee- \$35. Open to all Jr/ Am riders competing in the 2'3 Jr/Am Hunter Division at this show. The first 2'3 Jr/Am Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round will be a will be the second 2'3 Jr/Am Hunter O/F round and will be a handier course with tests such as a trot fence, rollback or halt. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place.

Riders must be confirmed entered with the in-gate prior to riding their 1st Hunter O/F round for scores to count.

\$250 Pony Hunter Classic

Class 72, entry fee- \$35. Open to all Jr/ Am riders competing in the Pony Hunter at this show. The first Pony Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round will be a will be the second Pony Hunter O/F round and will be a handier course with tests such as a trot fence, rollback or halt. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place. Riders must be confirmed entered with the in-gate prior to riding their 1st Hunter O/F round for scores to count.

\$500 Texas Rose Horse Park 2'6" Hunter Derby

(Only 1 class offered, split between Saturday & Sunday)

Class 200, Entry fee \$50 members, \$100 non-members. Fence height 2'6'' - 2'9'' with 3'0'' options. Open to all amateur, junior and professional riders. 1^{st} round: classic hunter course of at least 10 jumps including and in and out and minimum of 3 option fences. 2^{nd} round: Handy hunter course of the top 12 horses if available. 1 bonus point will be awarded for each option jump completed and in the 2^{nd} round up to 10 points may be awarded for handiness. No schooling of the course is allowed. Late entries will ride at the top of the order. 30 minutes prior to the class entries may walk the course with horses in hand only. **Ponies competing in this class may not cross enter into the \$250 Pony Hunter Derby.** 3 sets of ribbons $1^{st} - 12^{th}$ will be awarded.





This release shall be binding upon the heirs, personal representatives, executors and administrators of the undersigned. Likewise, it shall be binding upon all guests of the undersigned.

In signing the foregoing release, the undersigned hereby acknowledges and represents that he has read the foregoing release, understands it, and signs it voluntarily, and that he is over eighteen (18) years of age and of sound mind, or the parent or legal guardian of the participant, over eighteen (18) years of age and of sound mind.
