NTHJC GUIDELINES

Entries: Please submit entries by email to Blair Kenley at blair@kbranchllc.com. Entries are due by May 19th 2021 and June 9th, 2021. A maximum late fee of \$25 per horse/rider combination may be charged for entries received after the dates above.

Stall fees: \$75 with shavings.

Class fees: \$20 per class, Hunter Derby fee: \$55, Classic fee: \$35

Office fee: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$5 per day. An EMT will be on the grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$20.00 Office/ Scholarship fee per entry will be charged

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper: entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. High Point awards to be given at NTHJC Banquet.

Coggins: No entry will be accepted without a copy of a negative coggins (EIA) within one year, which may be emailed with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival.

Stalls: Limited amount of stalls will be available Friday at Noon through Sunday. Stalls are 12'X12' permanent with pine shavings. No outside shavings.

RV Space: Contact Blair at 940-536-8780 for RV availability.

Arenas: Covered Arena 125'x225' with sand footing. Outdoor Arena 110' x 250' with sand footing. Schooling ring is 100'x200' with sand footing.

Schooling: There will be open schooling Friday from 12pm -6pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from Daylight until the stated start times on schedule. No jumper or Derby schooling.

Medal Classes: It is open to all riders for the entire show season. The Top 12 point earners for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the NTHJC Year End Show.

Limit Divisions: are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning 5 blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in the division for the remainder of the show season. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at the same show. Riders will receive YEAR END AWARDS for the Limit Divisions!

Cross Entries: Horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference.

Awards: Classes receive a 1st place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

Attire: Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts with collars are allowed in jumper classes only. No chaps allowed.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on the show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: all dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

Warning: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

Concessions available during show hours Saturday & Sunday.

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split.

Equitation Divisions: The Equitation over Fences, Equitation on the Flat and the NTHJC Medal Class will be considered a division at each height and a Champion/Reserve award will be given, provided all three classes are held. All division rules apply.

Golf carts or any other motorized vehicles: At KB Shows, drivers of any motorized vehicles, including cars, golf carts, dirt bikes, vespas, etc. must have a valid driver's license

CLASSES: ENTRY FEES - \$20 per Class

Limit Equitation Poles - riders may only cross enter into Limit Equitation Crossrails. Poles once around and open to riders in their first year of showing

Limit Equitation Crossrails - Trot crossrails once around. Riders may only cross enter into Limit Equitation Poles or Limit Equitation 18".

Rusty Stirrup 18" Hunter Division: Open to Amateur riders 18 years of age or older. Full course of 18" verticals.

Short Stirrup 18" Hunter Division: Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age. Full course of 18" verticals.

Open 2'0" Hunter Division: Without Oxers Open to all riders. Horse/Rider Combination may not cross enter into Junior/Amateur Hunter 2'0"

Junior/Amateur 2'0" Hunter Division: Without Oxers Open to junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into 2'0 Open Hunter.

SPECIAL CLASSES:

NTHJC Hunter Derby-

Class 71, entry fee- \$55. Open to all horses and ponies who have competed in a division at this show. Fence heights are 2'6"-2'9" with option jumps up to 3'0". 1st round: Classic Hunter course of at least 10 jumps including an in and out and minimum of 3 options. 2nd Round: Handy Hunter Course of top 12 horses if available. 1 bonus point will be awarded for each option jump completed and in the second round up to 10 bonus points may be awarded for handiness. No schooling of the course is allowed. Late entries will ride at the top of the order. 30 minutes prior to the class, entries may walk the course with horse in hand only. 3 sets of ribbons through 12th place will be awarded; each round and overall winners.

Derby order of go will be posted at the office by noon Saturday. Adds received after noon Saturday will go at the top of the order. Adds close 30 minutes before the start of the class.

2'0" Hunter Classic-

Class 72, entry fee- \$35. Open to all Jr/ Am riders competing in the 2'0" Jr/Am Hunter Division at this show. The second 2'0" Jr/Am Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round will be a handy course with tests such as one option jump, trot fence, rollback or halt. Two bonus points will be awarded for a completed option jump. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place.

2'3" Hunter Classic

Class 73, entry fee- \$35. Open to all Jr/ Am riders competing in the 2'3" Hunter Division at this show. The second 2'3" Jr/Am Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round is a handy course with tests such as one option jump, trot fence, rollback or halt. Two bonus points will be awarded for a completed option jump. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place.

Pony Hunter Classic-

Class 74, entry fee- \$35. To be eligible to enter the Pony Hunter Classic, the same pony/rider combination must have competed in the Pony Division. The second Pony Hunter O/F class will be scored as the 1st round of the hunter classic. The 2nd round is a handy course with tests such as one option jump, trot fence, rollback or halt. Two bonus points will be awarded for a completed option jump. Both rounds' scores will be combined for the final score. Ribbons will be awarded through 8th place.

Future Jumper Classic-

Class 75, entry fee- \$35. Table I/Sec.2b, Fences 2'3"

Open to horses competing in the Future Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place.

Puddle Jumper Classic-

Class 76, entry fee- \$35. Table I/Sec.2b, Fences 2'6"-2'9"

Open to horses competing in the Puddle Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place.

Schooling Jumper Classic-

Class 77, entry fee- \$35. Table I/Sec.2b, Fences 3'0"-3'3"

Open to horses competing in the Schooling Jumper Division. Ribbons awarded 1st-8th place.

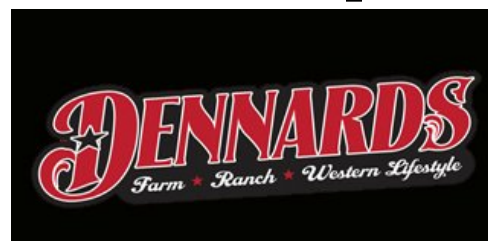
